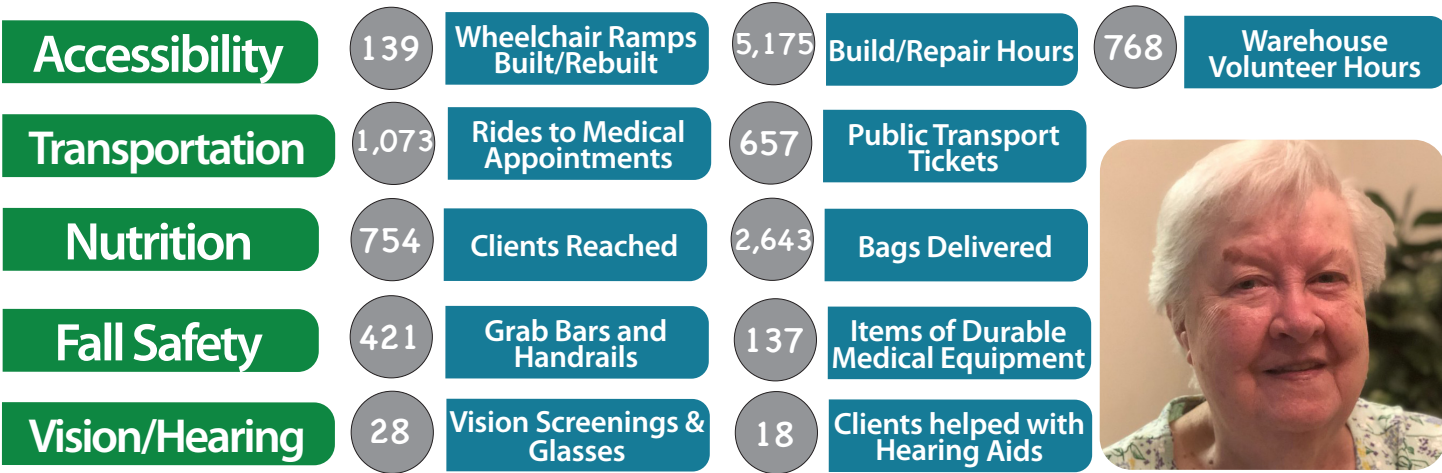

**2,635 Clients enabled by CASA services to *age in place*.**



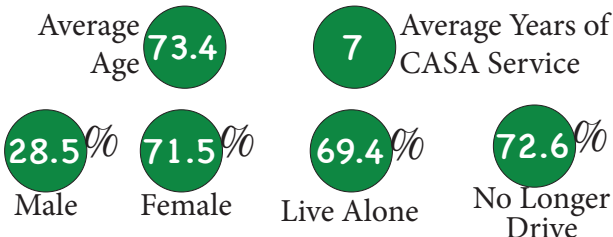

CASA’s volunteers invested **\$492,121.36** back into the Madison County community.



CASA's FY 2018-2019 audit reported program service expenses as **\$488,976** of the **\$590,039** total agency expenditures. Administrative and fundraising expenses totaled **17%**.
